Budget and Enrollment Numbers

Enrollment numbers are good. Armchair travel is especially strong with almost 1000 attendees.

Follow up to IMSCC Questions

Are there any METCO students attending IMSCC classes?

- There are no METCO students enrolled in the music school. Often there are inquiries but no follow up registrations.
- We should continue to gather information perhaps by checking with the METCO director about generating a parent survey.
- Also speak with the middle school music director to get his assessment.

At what ages does enrollment drop off:

- As might be expected, students drop out most often at transitions between elementary/middle school and middle school/high school.
- Discussion about what might incentivize more participation or continued participation? Instrument
- Enrollment is getting closer to pre-pandemic numbers.

Drivers' Education

Instructor Update

- We are continuously hiring. 60+ hours of training are required to be an instructor, then application to RMV and certification.
- A hire at this time may be ready to work by June.
- Currently training one new person.
- Need 1 or 2 new hires.
- Pay is \$25/hr weekday lessons, \$35/hour classroom teaching
- Widen the net to post these jobs at places where the odd hours complement part time jobs or retired populations: preschool teachers, custodians, public works, town employee sites, Beede, Lincoln Commons, Newbury Court, Council on Aging, retired police officers.

Director

Rebecca Gurley, Director of Drivers' Ed, is retiring the end of the summer.

CCACE Advisory Committee Meeting

- Jill is hoping to do interviews in May.
- She will include a member of the CCACE staff and an advisory council member to be on the interview team.
- The job is 25 hr/wk plus the option to add teaching hours.

Cars

- A car is being retired in 12/2024. RMV mandates that cars are removed every 10 years.
- Fleet is usually 5 cars.
- A decision has not been made whether to replace it quickly or wait until more instructors are hired to use it.
- On most Saturdays all of the cars are in use.
